VILLAGES & VIEWS

OIA

World-famous for its sunset and whitewashed architecture. Arrive early to secure a good viewing spot, especially in high season.

FIRA

The vibrant capital of the island with caldera views, shops and nightlife. Ideal for an afternoon stroll and evening drinks.

IMEROVIGLI

A quieter alternative with breathtaking views over the caldera. Perfect for romantic walks and sunset without the crowds.

PYRGOS

A charming, less crowded village offering panoramic island views. Best visited at sunset for a more authentic experience.

BEACHES

1_RED BEACH

A striking beach with red volcanic cliffs. Access requires a short walk—wear proper shoes.

2_PERISSA BEACH

A long black-sand beach with beach bars and restaurants. Ideal for a full day by the sea.

3_KAMARI BEACH

Organized beach with a lively promenade. Perfect for swimming, dining and relaxed evenings.

NATURE & EXPERIENCES

4_NEA KAMENI

Volcanic island at the heart of the caldera. Accessible by boat—bring water and sun protection.

5_HOT SPRINGS

Thermal waters near Palea Kameni, known for their unique color. Best combined with a boat excursion.

6_FIRA TO OIA TRAIL

Scenic hiking route along the caldera. Start early morning or late afternoon to avoid the heat.

7_THIRASSIA

A quiet island just across the caldera, offering a glimpse of traditional Santorini. Reachable by boat—ideal for a peaceful day trip.

8_AKROTIRI

Well-preserved prehistoric city often called the “Pompeii of the Aegean.” Visit with a guide for deeper insight.

9_ANCIENT THERA

Ruins of an ancient city with panoramic views. Accessible by car or hiking—ideal for history lovers.
